# Four Principles

- **The electric power grid must meet our energy needs at all times.**
  - Power sources, taken together, must be available 24-7-365 with sufficient capacity to meet everyone's energy needs.
- **New Yorker's livelihoods must be enhanced and not harmed by this transition.**
  - We need a national and global approach towards emissions reductions.
- **We must reduce emissions at the lowest possible costs**
  - Energy efficiency continues to be the most cost-effective way to reduce emissions. Also, focus on conversion of the most carbon-intensive fuels first.
- **All emission reduction solutions should be on the table; and right now, they're not**
  - Over the next 20 to 30 years, we should be flexible enough to incorporate new and developing technologies as potential energy resources.
